 - IT Infrastructure
 - Clinical Documents (HL7, CDA)
 - Radiology and/or Cardiology departmental workflow
 - Laboratory and/or Pharmacy
 - Patient Care Devices
 - Patient Care Coordination & Quality, Research, and Public Health
